Top Comments on Conservation

- Importance of planning for the future to address changing needs and minimize impacts of future growth on environmental resources
- Importance of developing a multimodal transportation system to accomplishing regional conservation goals
- Need to establish policies for protecting key resources at the start of the process



Top Comments on Countryside

- Need to work with agricultural land owners to provide dedicated conservation land.
- Work with agricultural landowners to understand connectivity needs and how they can support other regional goals
- Working ranches are important to wildlife
- Agriculture is critical for long-term regional economy, environment, and sustainability



Top Comments on Centers

- Need for better east/west connectivity to Brevard County
- Need to better connect economic centers
- Need for a regional approach to developing and funding public transportation

Top Comments on Corridors

- Need for better east/west connectivity for emergency evacuation and economic development
- Specific connectivity gaps: to/from Poinciana; Brevard County to Lake Nona; population centers to educational hubs; International Drive to Orlando
- Need to avoid impact of roads on existing communities including eminent domain
- Need for better coordination among stakeholders



Future Citizen Workshops
